

Public FedVTE Courses FAQ

Tracking

Cookies are used to track course progress/completion on public FedVTE. Since there is no login requirement, this is the only useful method of tracking course progress. If you do not want the cookies to track your progress you can opt out, but that will mean that the system will not be able to track your progress as you move through the course.

Certificates

Course certificates of completion are available to print or download immediately following the completion of a course. If you do not print a certificate at the end of the course, there will be no way in which to generate a certificate at a later date since no data is stored on public customers to the FedVTE site.

CEU and CPE Credits

There is no guarantee that the various certification governing bodies will grant CPE or CEU credits for the completion of FedVTE public courses.

Please note that when you generate your course certificate, all tracking information for that course will be erased. You should download or print your certificate at that time.
